Breakfast Club

We are pleased to confirm that from September 2021 our Breakfast Club will return to a 7.45am opening. There will be a charge of £3.00 per child (which includes breakfast) with any additional siblings charged at £2.50. The club runs until 8.45am each day. Breakfast is served up until 8.20am. Children can choose from a range of cereals and toast; fresh fruit and juice is always available. After breakfast, the children can choose from a variety of activities and games. The Breakfast Club staff also work as Teaching Assistants within the school. The Club is always very well attended and enjoyed by the children who attend. As with this year, bookings are open on School Money (a week in advance, so that we can plan staffing levels) at 8.30am every Monday and will close at 4pm every Thursday. Please email the school office if you have any issues booking during these times.

Term Dates

School will reopen on **Monday 6th September** for Years 1-6. It will open on Monday 13th September for our Reception Class and Nursery.

In addition to the term dates already set, we need to add two further dates. For the Queen's Platinum Jubilee an additional bank holiday has been added nationally. As the school is already on half term break at this time we have decided to take our day on **6**th **December**. The school will therefore be closed to all staff and pupils on this day.

We have also been informed by our Trust, St Ralph Sherwin Catholic Multi-Academy Trust, that we need to allocate an additional INSET Training day this coming year. This is the same for all schools within our Trust. We have therefore allocated **2**nd **December**. I understand that this is not ideal for you as parents and carers however, I have put the dates together so that you are able to plan accordingly. An amended list of term dates will be sent out shortly.

School Start and Finish Times

In September, we will revert to our pre-COVID school opening times. This means that gates will open at 8.45am and close at 8.55am. We will, however, continue to use the multiple gate system we are using at present, which is as follows: -

Y1 – Gate on Newhall Road (the same gate Reception and Y1 have used this year)

Y2 – Down the front ramp, by the school office

Y3 & Y4 – Top Ramp, through Church car park, by the shrine

Y5 & Y6 - Double gates, down the front ramp, by the kitchen

At the end of the day, Reception and Year 1 will finish at 3.10pm. All other year groups will finish at 3.15pm. All year groups will exit via the same gate they came in and teachers will bring the children to the gate.
