Science Provision

We are very fortunate to have Miss Prabatani working with the Ogden Trust. She is the hub leader for the local area and through her hard work, we have been able to significantly enhance our science resources and provision. We have received items for a Space Camp, which we hope to be able to use in the summer. This week we received six telescopes and six sets of binoculars. This was after Miss Prabatani was successful in her presentation to The Worshipful Company of Glass Sellers of London who then provided us with a grant of £1000 to be spent on buying the telescopes. It is a wonderful achievement. The next project is hopefully the creation of a Phiz Lab in school, again with the support of the Ogden Trust.
