### Wraparound Care

Our after school club is up and running. Numbers are quite low at the moment so we are hoping that there will be a greater up-take over the coming weeks. The club is run by our own staff, led by Mrs Morris and supported by Mrs Aucote, Mrs McInulty or Mrs Murphy. The club runs every day straight after school until 5.30pm. Prices are as follows:

3.15 - 4.30pm - £7.00; 4.30 - 5.30pm - £7.00 or 3.15 - 5.30pm - £10.00

Our Breakfast Club also runs from 7.45am each day at a cost of £3 per pupil per session.

Bookings can be made online at School Money. If you would like to pay for either provision using childcare vouchers the bookings cannot be made online, please email the school office instead and we can do this for you. Unfortunately, any bookings made will be charged for unless your child is absent that day. This is because staff ratios will have been put in place. #### 2023-2024 Academic Year.

The deadline to apply for a place for your child is midnight on 15th January 2023. Please ensure that your applications are submitted before the deadline and all supporting evidence including the Supplementary Form. Please apply for your child's place through Derbyshire, click <u>HERE</u> to be directed to the page. The Supplementary Form must be completed and sent in to school together with any supporting evidence.

Even if your child currently attends our Nursery you will still need to apply for a place in our Reception class.
